The report must have been produced between 1st June 2015 and the 31st May 2016. The candidature must comprise a single report. The length of the Report must be between **1 minute and 6 minutes**. The Report submitted must be identical to the broadcast piece.*

Personal data made known to the Organiser are processed within the framework of the principles implemented by the latter for the processing of personal data in accordance with the French law on personal data protection of 6 January 1978, as modified. In accordance with this law, candidates/journalists have the right to access, rectify and delete information concerning them at any time. These rights may be exercised with the Organiser.
